Success for All Schools in Michigan Gain on MEAP – Reading

Michigan schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP) – Reading scale. **From 2005 to 2008, Michigan Success for All schools had a 7.1 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–5 who met or exceeded standards.** Other Michigan schools gained 2.0 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Detroit Public School Academy: 23.3%
- Henry J. Owen Elementary in Pontiac: 18.2%
- Detroit Academy of Arts and Sciences: 10.2%
