Success for All Schools in California Gain on CST – Reading

California schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the California Standards Test (CST) – Reading scale. **From 2004 to 2008, California Success for All schools had a 12.8 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 2–6 who scored proficient or above.** Other California schools gained 10.7 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Sara Coughlin Elementary in Los Angeles: 33.0%
- Grant Elementary in San Jose: 25.8%
- Cesar Chavez Elementary on Norwalk-La Mirada: 23.3%
- Landers Elementary in Morongo: 21.9%
- Whitney Avenue Elementary in San Juan: 21.7%
- Bahia Vista Elementary in San Rafael: 17.8%
- Pioneer Elementary in Weaver Union: 17.0%
- Pacoima Charter School in Los Angeles: 16.8%
- Fillmore Elementary in Stockton: 16.6%
- Orangewood Elementary in West Covina: 15.5%
- Fair Oaks Elementary in Redwood City: 15.0%
