Success for All Elementary Schools in Oregon Gain on OSA – Reading

For the past eight years, Oregon elementary schools using the Success for All reading program have made significant gains on the Oregon Statewide Assessment (OSA) – Reading scale. **From 2001 to 2009, Oregon Success for All schools had a 13.1 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who met or exceeded state standards.** Overall, Oregon elementary schools only gained 0.6 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Lake Labish Elementary in Salem-Keizer: 24.2%
- Kennedy Elementary in Salem-Keizer: 21.6%
- Oakland Elementary in Oakland: 21.2%
- Brooks Elementary in Gervais: 20.8%
