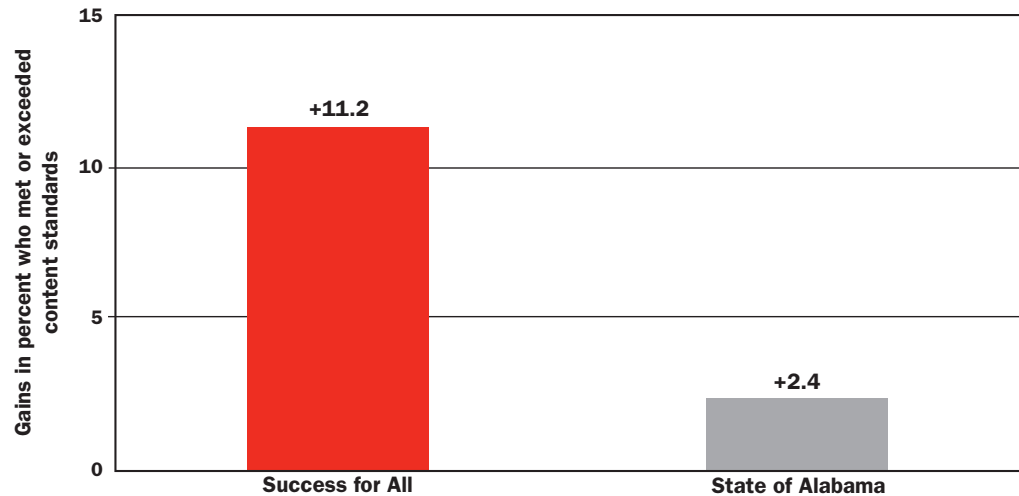
Success for All Schools in Alabama Gain on ARMT – Reading

Alabama schools using the Success for All reading program once again made outstanding progress on the Alabama Reading and Mathematics Test (ARMT) – Reading scale. **From 2005 to 2008, Alabama Success for All schools had an 11.2 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who met or exceeded content standards.** Other Alabama schools gained 2.4 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- J. S. Abrams Elementary in Bessemer: 22.5%
- Jonesboro Elementary in Bessemer: 16.9%
- Red Bay High School in Franklin County: 14.5%
- C. F. Hard Elementary in Bessemer: 14.3%
