## Success for All Elementary Schools in Nevada Gain on CRT – Reading

Nevada elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Nevada Criterion-Referenced Test (CRT) – Reading scale. **From 2002 to 2009, Nevada Success for All schools had a 17.2 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who scored proficient or above.** Overall, Nevada elementary schools gained 9.3 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Natchez Elementary in Washoe County: 52.0%
- Lincoln-Edison Elementary in Clark County: 31.3%
- Crestwood-Edison Elementary in Clark County: 27.1%
- Empire Elementary in Carson City: 23.7%
- Jack Dailey Elementary in Clark County: 20.6%
