Success for All Schools in Texas Gain on TAKS – Reading

Texas elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2009, Texas Success for All schools had a 2.2 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–5 who met standards.** Other Texas schools gained 0.6 percentage points. Although 76% of Success for All students receive free or reduced lunches compared to 47% for the state, Success for All schools now score higher than the state average with 87% of the students meeting standards (vs. 85.3% for the state).

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Burrus Elementary in Houston ISD: **20.7%**
- Hidalgo Elementary in Hidalgo ISD: **13.0%**
- Scott Elementary in Houston ISD: **10.7%**
- Zavala Elementary in Harlingen ISD: **10.3%**
- Dolores Linton Elementary in San Antonio-Northside ISD: **10.0%**
