Success for All Elementary and Middle Schools in Florida Gain on FCAT – Reading

Florida elementary and middle schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant progress on the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2009, Florida Success for All elementary schools had a 7.3 percentage-point increase in the number of students who scored at or above Achievement Level 3.** Other Florida elementary schools gained 2.5 percentage points. **Florida Success for All middle schools had a 5.4 percentage-point increase in the number of students who scored at or above Achievement Level 3.** Other Florida middle schools gained 1.0 percentage point.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

Elementary Schools:

- Choices in Learning Charter School: 20.4%
- Milestones Elementary School in Lake County: 12.3%
- Kelley Smith Elementary School in Putnam County: 10.4%
- Liza Jackson Charter in Okaloosa County: 9.8%
- Hamilton Elementary School in Seminole County: 9.3%

Middle Schools:

- Millennium Middle School in Seminole County: 10.7%
- Sanford Middle School in Seminole County: 10.3%
- Q. I. Roberts Middle School in Putnam County: 9.7%
- Lawton Chiles Middle School in Seminole County: 9.0%
