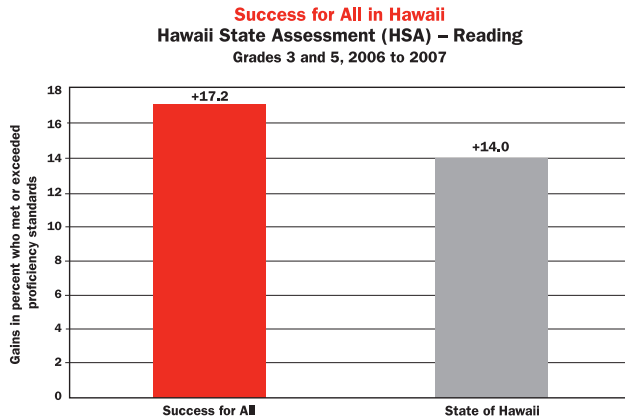


Success for Hawaii

Success for All Schools in Hawaii Gain on HSA – Reading

Hawaii schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Hawaii State Assessment (HSA) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2007, Hawaii Success for All schools had a 17.2 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3 and 5 who met or exceeded proficiency standards.** Overall, Hawaii schools gained 14.0 percentage points.



Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

Pa'auilo Elementary in Hawaii	33.5%
Pahoa Elementary in Hawaii	31.5%
Kapa'a Elementary in Kauai	25.0%
Waimanalo Elementary in Windward	23.0%
Laie Elementary in Windward	22.5%
Honoka'a Elementary in Hawaii	22.5%
Ka'a'awa Elementary in Windward	22.5%
Pohakea Elementary in Leeward	21.0%
August Ahrens Elementary in Leeward	20.0%
Ka'ala Elementary in Central Oahu	19.0%
Keonepoko Elementary in Hawaii	15.0%

The 2007 results mirror findings in schools throughout the United States. Success for All schools typically gain more than other schools on state accountability tests.
