

# Success for All Elementary Schools in Atlanta Gain on CRCT – Reading

Atlanta elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on Georgia's Criterion-Referenced Competency Test (CRCT) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2008, Success for All elementary schools had a 13.6 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 1–5 who met or exceeded standards.** Other Atlanta elementary schools gained 7.5 percentage points, and elementary schools in the state of Georgia gained 4.7 percentage points.

Elementary schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Alfred Blalock Elementary: 23.8%
- D. H. Stanton Elementary: 22.2%
- E. L. Connally Elementary: 21.8%
- J. W. Dobbs Elementary: 21.6%
- Woodson Elementary: 20.3%
- Perkerson Elementary: 16.3%
- Benteen Elementary: 16.1%
- Cleveland Avenue Elementary: 15.7%
- Mary M. Bethune Elementary: 14.3%
- Finch Elementary: 13.9%
- T. H. Slater Elementary: 13.8%

*The 2008 results mirror previous findings in Atlanta schools and in Success for All schools throughout the United States. Success for All schools typically show greater gains than other schools on state assessments.*
