

## Success for All Middle Schools in Atlanta Gain on CRCT – Reading

Atlanta middle schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on Georgia's Criterion-Referenced Competency Test (CRCT) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2008, Success for All middle schools had a 12.9 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 6–8 who met or exceeded standards.** Other Atlanta middle schools gained 7.4 percentage points, and Georgia schools overall gained 5.0 percentage points. Every Success for All middle school in Atlanta gained more than the state average gain of 5 percent.

Middle schools with outstanding gains for this period include:

- Parks Middle: 22.1%
- J. F. Kennedy Middle: 18.7%
- Harper Archer Middle: 13.2%
- L. J. Price Middle: 9.7%
- Sylvan Hills Middle: 9.1%
- Brown Middle: 8.9%
- C. W. Long Middle: 8.8%

*The 2008 results mirror previous findings in Atlanta schools and in Success for All schools throughout the United States. Success for All middle schools typically show greater gains than other schools on state assessments.*
