Success for All Elementary Schools in North Carolina Gain on End-of-Grade – Reading

North Carolina elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made outstanding progress on the End-of-Grade Reading assessments. **From 2008 to 2009, North Carolina Success for All schools had a 13.0 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–5 who scored at or above Achievement Level III.** Overall, North Carolina elementary schools gained 11.3 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Old Richmond Elementary in Forsyth County: 20.4%
- Children's Village Academy in Lenoir County: 19.8%
- C. G. Woodson School in Winston-Salem: 14.3%
- Pleasant Garden Elementary in Guilford County: 14.0%
