Success for All Schools in Illinois Gain on ISAT – Reading

Illinois schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT) – Reading scale. **From 2005 to 2008, Illinois Success for All schools had a 15.7 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who met or exceeded standards.** Other Illinois schools gained 11.3 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Primary Academic Center in Prairie Hills: 39.4%
- Park Elementary in Dolton: 32.9%
- Thomas Chalmers School in Chicago: 30.8%
- Edmund Burke Elementary in Chicago: 30.4%
- Lincoln Avenue School in Dolton: 22.9%
- Crispus Attucks Academy in Chicago: 22.2%
- Bryant Elementary in Harvey: 20.0%
- Hans Christian Andersen Academy in Chicago: 19.4%
- Brian Piccolo School in Chicago: 15.7%
- Washington School in Dolton: 14.3%
- Franklin Elementary in Dolton: 14.3%
