Success for All Elementary Schools in Pennsylvania Gain on PSSA – Reading

Pennsylvania elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made outstanding gains on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) – Reading test. **From 2005 to 2009, Pennsylvania Success for All schools had a 14.4 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who scored at proficient and above.** Overall, Pennsylvania schools increased by 6.2 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Main Street School in Chester Upland: **44.8%**
- Aliquippa Elementary in Aliquippa: **32.4%**
- Toby Farms Elementary in Chester Upland: **24.2%**
- West Oak Lane Charter in Philadelphia: **14.5%**
- Laurel Valley Elementary in Ligonier Valley: **10.1%**
