Success for All Elementary Schools in Maryland Gain on MSA – Reading

Maryland elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Maryland School Assessment (MSA) – Reading scale. **From 2005 to 2009, Maryland Success for All schools had a 16.2 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–5 who scored proficient or advanced.** Overall, Maryland elementary schools gained 10.0 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Choptank Elementary in Dorchester: 27.2%
- Warwick Elementary in Dorchester: 17.7%
- Grasonville Elementary in Queen Anne’s County: 16.7%
