

## Success for All Middle Schools in Missouri Gain on MAP – Communication Arts

Missouri middle schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) – Communication Arts scale. **From 2006 to 2008, Success for All middle schools had an 8.9 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 6–8 who scored at proficient or above.** Overall, Missouri middle schools gained 5.3 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Wendell Phillips K–8 in Kansas City: 26.8%
- Trailwoods K–8 in Kansas City: 16.0%
- Foreign Language Academy in Kansas City: 15.2%
- J. A. Rogers Middle School in Kansas City: 11.4%
- Richards R5 Elementary/Middle in Richards: 8.5%
- Clifford H. Nowlin Middle in Kansas City: 7.3%
- East K–8 in Kansas City: 7.2%
- Kansas City Middle School of the Arts: 7.2%
- Morgan County R-II Middle in Morgan County: 7.1%

*The 2008 results mirror previous findings in Missouri and in Success for All middle schools throughout the United States. Success for All middle schools typically show greater gains than other schools on state assessments.*
